A Note From Your Treasurer

30 April 2025

First Presbyterian Church ended the month of April with a bank balance of \$25,937 compared to \$73,970 at the end of April 2025.

Our income for the month of April, \$9,158, compared to only \$28,312 one year ago. Through the end of April, we transferred \$41,216 from our investments at Texas Presbyterian Foundation in order to have on hand adequate funds for anticipated expenses.

Expenses for April, \$5,604, were substantially lower than for the same month in 2024, \$14,486.

Below are the year-to-date numbers for the month of April 2025 compared to the same month one year previous.

As of April 30, 2025:

Receipts: \$85,036 \$60,555

Expenses: \$93,826 \$91,476 (\$30,921)

The mail continues to be received at the Grand Avenue address for the foreseeable future but as reported previously, our mailing address is now P.O. Box 31, Ponca City, OK, 74602.
