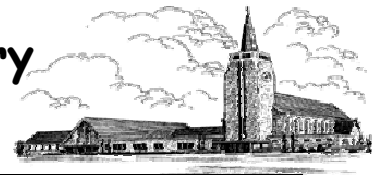

Program: Rev. Mary Wright will lead us in a transitional Bible Study.

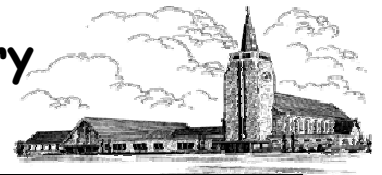
CZECH MISSION TRIP

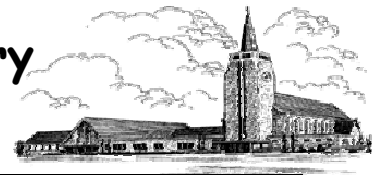
