A Note from Your Treasurer

31 January 2024

First Presbyterian finished the month of January with a bank balance of \$74,737 as a result, we will not need to draw from our investments to cover expenses during February. Income for January, \$12,013, was exceeded by our expenses, \$15,979, meaning the church operated at a loss of \$3,966, for the first month of the new year.
